## Letter Formation

- Practice writing upper and lowercase letters legibly.
- Learn correct stroke order for each letter.

## Capitalization

- Practice consistently using capital letters where required.
- Understand the use of capital letters for proper nouns (e.g., names of people, places, days of the week) and at the beginning of sentences.

## Spelling


- Spell commonly used words correctly.
- Use phonetic spelling to spell unfamiliar words.
- Recognize and spell words encountered in reading materials.

## Vocabulary

- Expand vocabulary through reading and listening.
- Use descriptive words (adjectives) to add detail to writing.
- Experiment with different adjectives to describe people, places, and things.

## Sentence Structure

- Practice writing simple sentences with subject-verb-object structure.
- Experiment with sentence length and structure to create variety.
- Understand that sentences begin with a capital letter and end with punctuation (period, question mark, exclamation mark).




## Composition

- Practice writing short narratives based on personal experiences or imaginative prompts.
- Begin to sequence events in stories using words like "first," "next," "then," and "finally."
- Introduce the concept of a beginning, middle, and end in stories.



## Punctuation

- Introduce basic punctuation marks (period, question mark, exclamation mark).
- Practice using punctuation correctly in sentences and short texts.



## Editing and Revising

- Begin to self-edit writing for capitalization, spelling, and punctuation errors.
- Revisit and revise writing to add details or clarify meaning.
